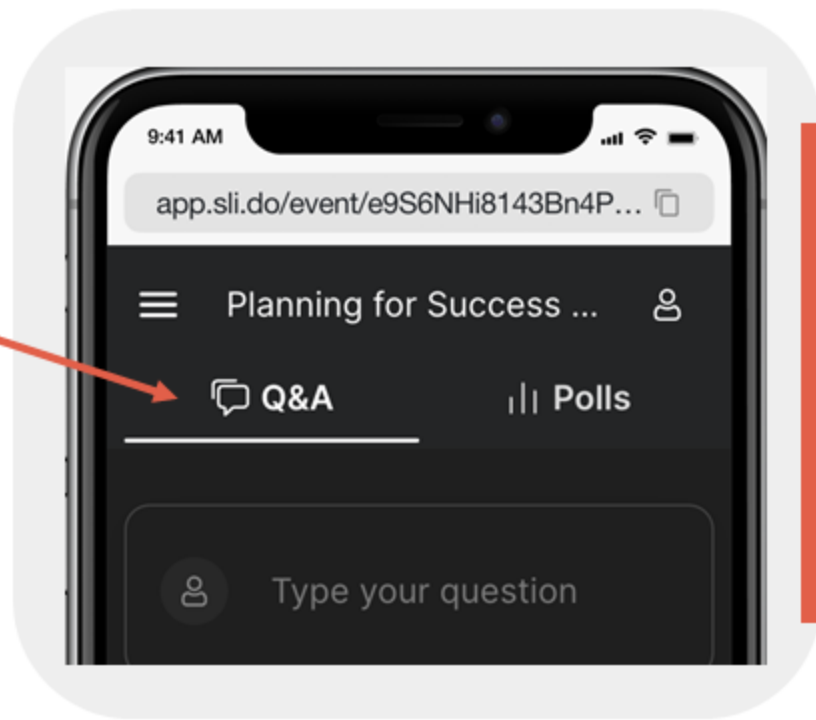

How to Plan a Service Project

- Know your end goal
- **Step 1:** Preparing to plan, ensuring commitment
- **Step 2:** Analyse the situation and needs
- **Step 3:** Prioritise and select the Goal and Purpose
- **Step 4:** Develop Clear Specific Objectives
- **Step 5:** Identify Alternative Strategies and Select the Most Effective Strategy
- **Step 6:** Plan implementation
- **Step 7:** Review and Celebrate
